



Teen Ambassador Program 2022-2023

General Description:

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Eastern North Carolina (RMHC-ENC) Teen Ambassador Program offers High School students on-site and virtual experiential learning. Students gain the ability to work with staff and learn more about our local chapter and global organization through various onsite and online projects. Over the course of 9 months from August-April, students and staff will work together to set expectations and complete projects.

The Teen Ambassador Program is comprised of a select group of high school students chosen based on academic merit and commitment to volunteering. Their purpose is to create awareness, raise funds and support the Ronald McDonald House of Eastern NC. This program gives teens a greater understanding of several aspects of a non-profit organization and shows them the importance of giving back to their community.

Time Commitment:

- About 10-15 hours per month

Qualification:

- Ages 15-18 (or incoming sophomore to senior)
- Seeking hours for school or scholarships
- Access to a computer (research/meeting purposes)
- Parental consent (see confidentiality/parental consent form) due before the start of the program

Expectations:

- Participate in activities listed on syllabus (provided during orientation).
- Participate in monthly/bi-monthly meetings with RMHC-ENC staff (1 hour).
- Communicate to staff any problems that might occur during the duration of the program (tech or otherwise).
- Proper use of technology when being used for RMHC-ENC purposes (professionalism in email and virtual communication)
- Be an ambassador for RMHC-ENC when engaging with your community
- Dress casual and respectful when representing RMHC-ENC in a public setting.
- Communicate to staff if you have ideas, questions or concerns regarding course material.
